"Photographing Your Art" on October 26th**

Led by Regina Madwed, Capitol PhotoInteractive's principal photographer, this session will cover the importance of lighting, formatting, and properly uploading your images onto the computer. The workshop will take place on Wednesday, October 26, from 12– 1:15 PM, at Capitol PhotoInteractive, located at 1139 Post Road in Fairfield. Capitol PhotoInteractive is a full-service professional photography, special event and web site design studio, celebrating over 35 years of service to Fairfield County.
